TUITION PAYMENT FOR 2018/2019 SCHOOL YEAR: If you wish to make a tuition loan for 2018/19, which will be with Metairie Bank, indicate that on the form that you will receive with your registration form. This year Metairie Bank will mail the **"Bank Activator"** to your home on **April 5, 2018**. This **"Bank Activator"** must be verified for correct information, signed and returned to the school office by **Friday, April 12, 2018**. A \$15.00 late charge will be assessed if the "bank activator" is not returned to the school office by Friday, April 12, 2018.

If you have not made a tuition loan with Metairie Bank previously, you must come to the school office to sign the bank loan papers the week of April 9-13, anytime from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. It will take only a few moments to complete and sign the loan papers. A \$15.00 late charge will be assessed if you sign the loan papers after April 13, 2018. If the loan is defaulted, a \$250 default charge will be assessed by SCS.
